RE:REPORT ON THE COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMME AT DONHOLM ON 18TH JUNE 2016.

On 18th June,2016 ESA and EBESA organized for a cleanup event at Donholm in conjunction with Environmental Sustainability led by Dr.Mbuge. The community work took place from 9am to 3pm in the evening. The cleanup focused on three specific locations within the area. Those who came for the cleanup were split into three groups. There were 70 students and a few staff members from the college of architecture and engineering. All members were provided with gloves for safety and equipment for the work. The community around, the local churches and a few other small organizations also took part in the cleanup process.
